New England Homebrew Jamboree – Join us on our annual trip to join home brewers from across the region for a weekend full of fun.

Swill-Off – Just to show a lighter side, every July we have a blind tasting and rating of the big boy brews, like Bud or Miller. Always a very enlightening event everyone looks forward to.

Octoberfest Tasting – Our October meeting features an Octoberfest competition where we pit the home-brews against the big boys in a blind taste off. For three years in a row, club members have beat out the likes of Sam Adams, Hacker Pschorr, Spaten and Harpoon.

Pub Crawl – Every April the club takes a pub crawl to visit a few of the many fine breweries here in the area. In the past we've done Boston, Cambridge, Worcester, MetroWest and Western Mass.

HOME-BREW CONTEST

Not only will you get constructive feedback on your beer, you'll also learn about the BJCP Style Guideline and evaluating beers by styles.
